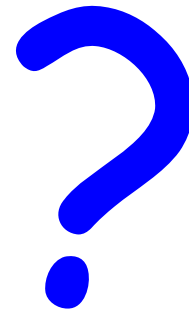




What Are Llamas Good For Anyway

1. **Llama Assisted Therapy** – for people struggling with behaviors associated with ADD, ADHD, defiance, high anxiety and poor impulse control.
2. **Seeing Eye for Other Animals** – great companions for other llamas and blind animals, e.g., sheep and goats.
3. **4-H** – for kids to work with animals, train and show them, and even use their fiber to make clothing, accessories and fun crafts.
4. **Small Animal Guards** – excellent protectors against predators that prey upon sheep, goats, calves, chickens and other small animals.
5. **Packing** – for recreational day or weekend hikes or for commercial long hauls in the back country for weeks.
6. **Fiber** – spinning, weaving, felting, stuffing, fly tying, garden mulch and more.
7. **Showing** – if you like competition and travel.
8. **Hunting & Fishing** – for packing game and fish out of hard to get to areas.
9. **Fertilizer** – weed free, odorless, high-nutrition manure for gardens and house plants, applied either fresh, dry, composted or as a “bean tea”
10. **Parades** – showcase your beautiful llama or lend them out to carry banners for local organizations and businesses.
11. **Cart Pulling** – great for functions, parades and more.
12. **Deer Repellent** – spread around gardens and yards to keep deer away.
