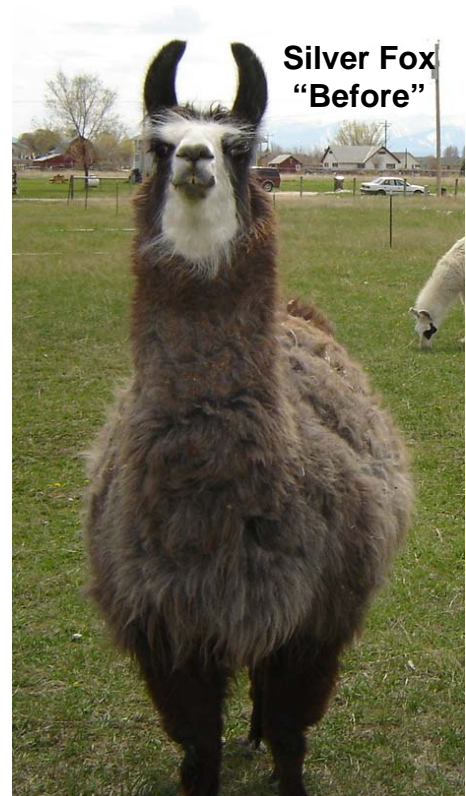


Feature Bio – “Silver Fox” By Char Hakes
